### ASMR MAILINGS

A good response has occurred so far from the second mailing which was made on August 7 to the Reclamation Matters mailing list. So far 161 ASMR members have returned the page regarding continuing to receive the magazine as a hard copy. Several indicated they wouldn't object if we had to go to an electronic magazine, but of these, the suggestion to put it on the web page would be desirable due to the size of the publication. To remind you, I currently place the magazine on the web page after the next issue has been mailed.

Of the 2100+ letters sent to non-ASMR members, only 78 returned the questionnaire, which was a very disappointing response. Of these, 15 indicated they didn't have email so the electronic mailing wasn't an option. Three indicated they didn't want the magazine at all and I removed their names from the listing. The good news from the survey is that 11 of the 78 respondents joined as regular members and 2 at the Corporate Membership level. This alone paid for the mailing costs. I am still hoping more will join ASMR in the future, and this number is double the number that has joined from the forms placed in the magazine over the past two and a half years. I have been receiving 2 or 3 new member per week the past month.

Letters were also sent to those who have had exhibit booths at the past four meetings. This has resulted in 9 becoming Corporate Members. A list of new Corporate Members occurs near the end of this newsletter. Those who have chosen this option have been placed on the web page in the new section "Mining and Reclamation Service Directory." It is my hope several more will participate based on conversations with the exhibitors, especially those at the meetings in 2006.

### MINING AND RECLAMATION SERVICES DIRECTORY

Several additional letters have been mailed recently to various companies who have purchased ads in Reclamation Matters, which included a Membership Application, the Membership Services Directory

Check List, and the Corporate Member Service Directory Form. These three items may be found on the **ASMR** web page under the above title. If you are associated with a company, we invite your company to become a Corporate Member as well. The initial phase of this new service is now on the web page and will be modified as this section is being developed.

This effort was initiated in order to improve the beneficial interaction between various companies and potential clients.
