



Program Outline

The course is comprised of three one-day sessions at a cost of \$85.00 per person for the entire 3-day course. To successfully complete the course and be recognized as a Kentucky Master Logger, participants must attend and participate in all three days. The training is mainly indoor with an outdoor field session. Wear comfortable work clothing. Dress according to the weather conditions. Course times are 9:00 am to 4:00 pm local time.

Important Program Information:

- a) Registration fee is nonrefundable within five (5) working days prior to the first day of training. Participants will be prioritized for class space up to five (5) working days before the class.
- b) If a participant cancels within five (5) working days or misses a session, he/she will be put on a waiting list for the next available training.
- c) The participant must provide personal transportation to field sites, as required at some locations.
- d) The participant must furnish personal protective equipment (PPE) hard hat. Under no circumstances will participants be allowed onto field sites without proper personal protective equipment.
